Wine First - the concept



Wine First is a unique new, and already an award winning, television series where wine and food are matched. In each exciting episode, hosts: sommeliers Liora Levi and Maya Samuelsson and food enthusiast Yolanda Añó search for three wines that reflect the character of each region, and then challenge a chef to prepare dishes to match the wines. Produced by Tellus Works Television AS, Wine First is presented and distributed nationally by American Public Television (APT3 and is currently showing in 48 states across the US with a 96% coverage of the country.

Throughout the series, Liora, Maya and Yolanda meet larger-than-life wine producers from renowned vineyards and learn first-hand the intricacies of creating the local wines. They explore what makes each wine special, taste local and regional delicacies, and share wine-tasting tips in an entertaining manner. In the finale of each episode, they enjoy a magnificent meal with the winemakers, and together they all decide if the chef has managed to prepare dishes that complement the distinctive characteristics of each of the chosen wines. They will prove that something special might happen if you simply put **wine first!**

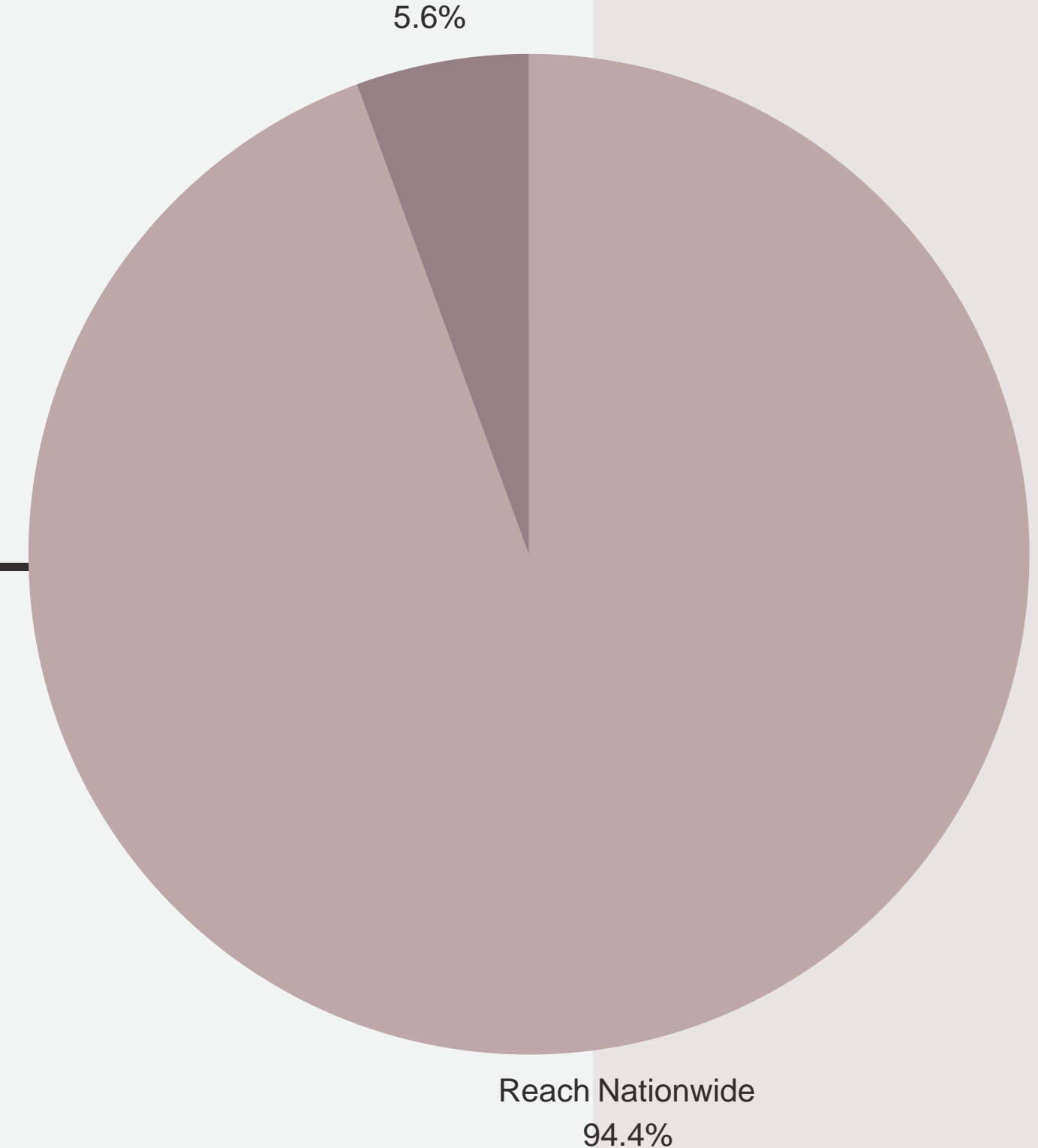

Actual reach in January 2022

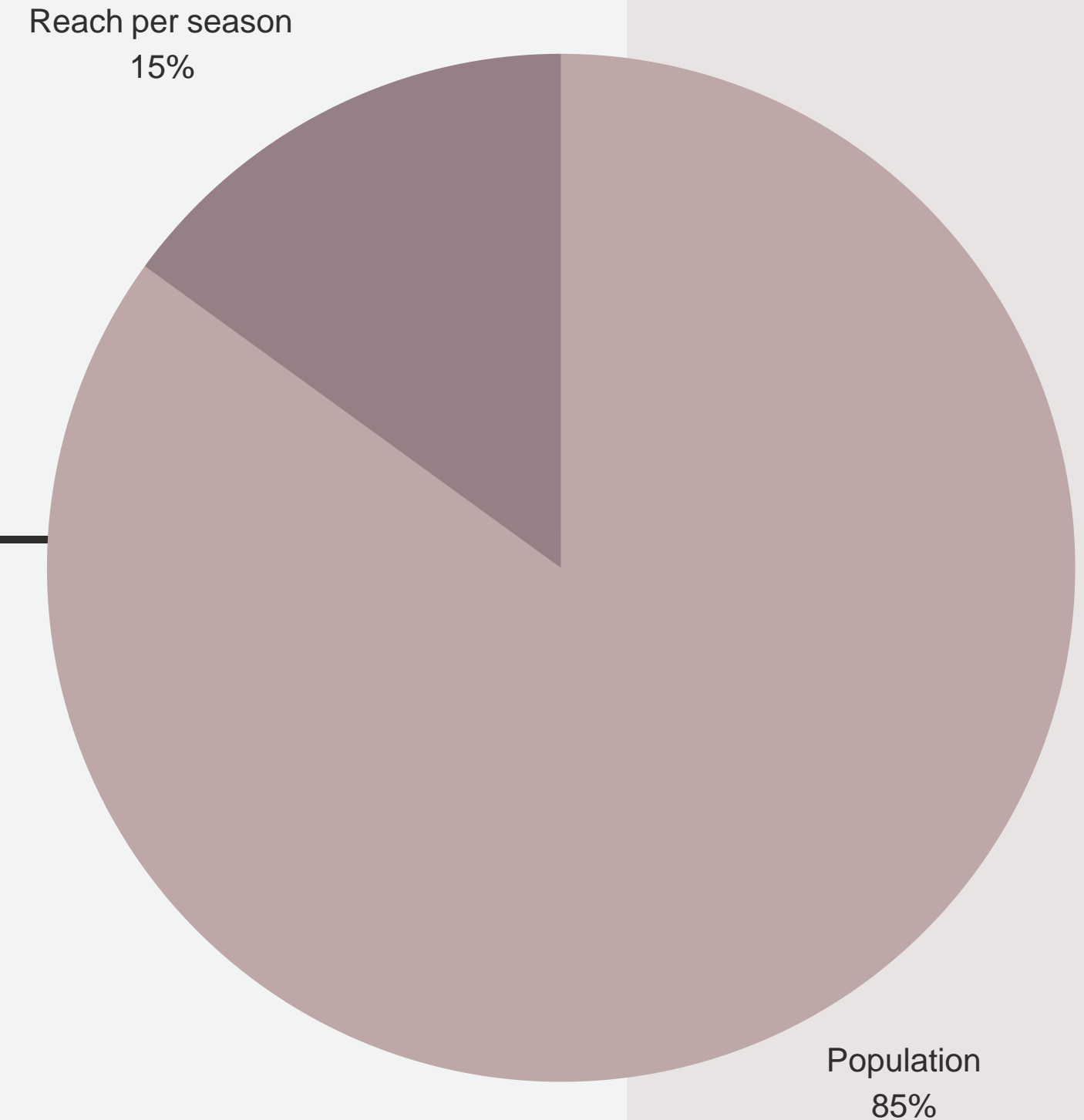

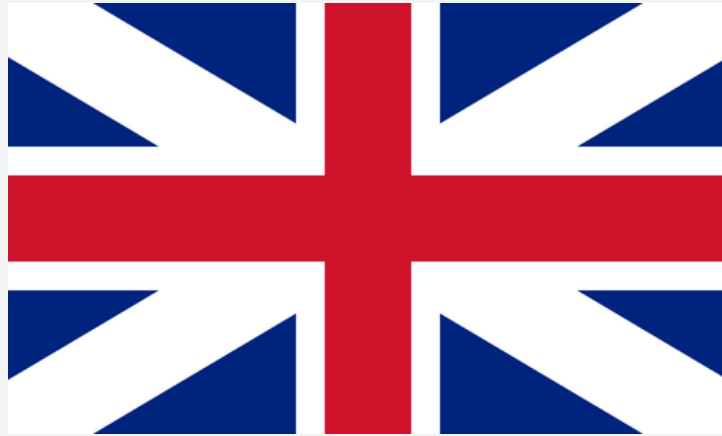
Potential reach per season

Accumulated figures so far calculate that each season has a potential reach of about 50 million viewers in the US in the course of 1 year.



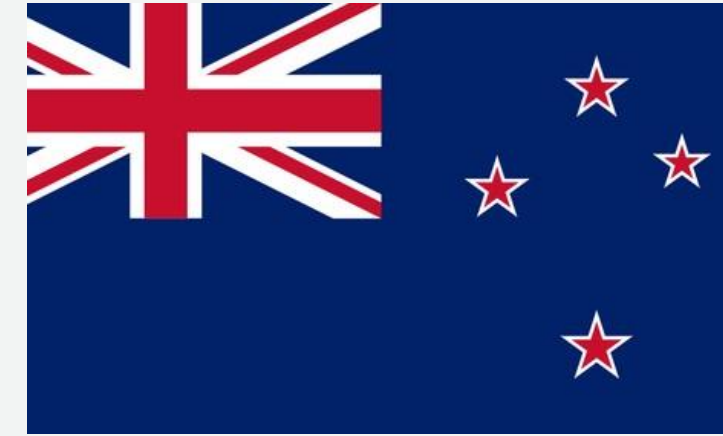
From 2022 distribution will also cover*



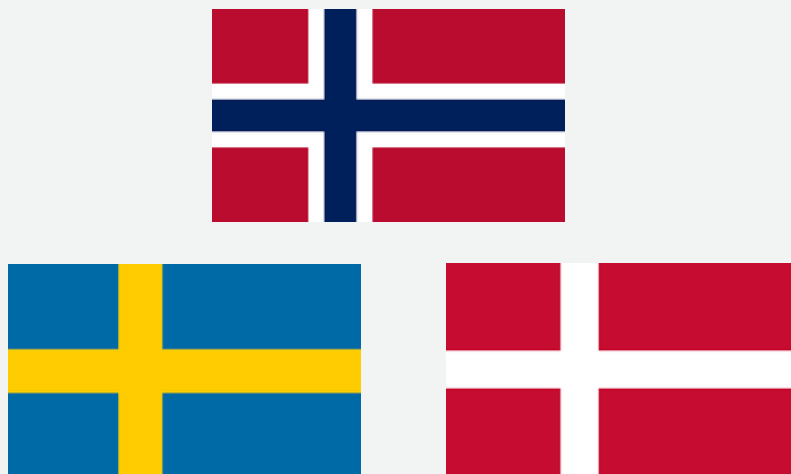
