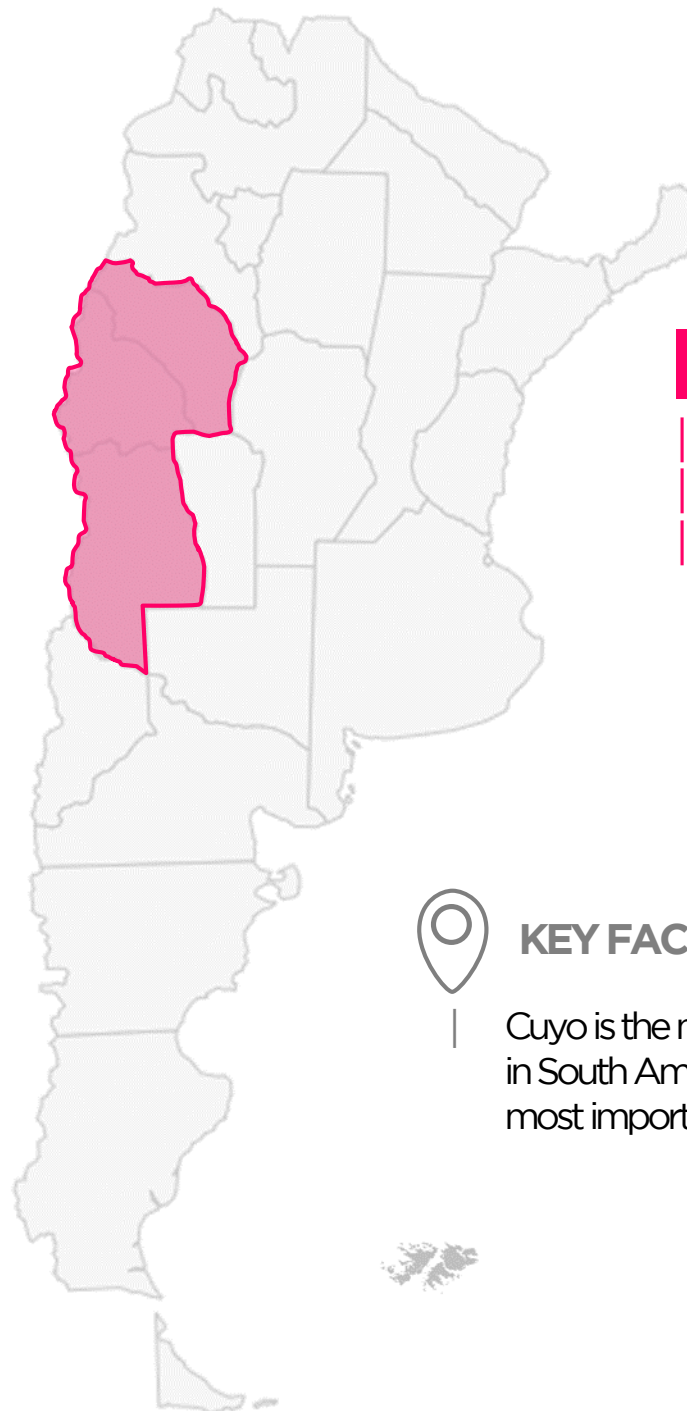

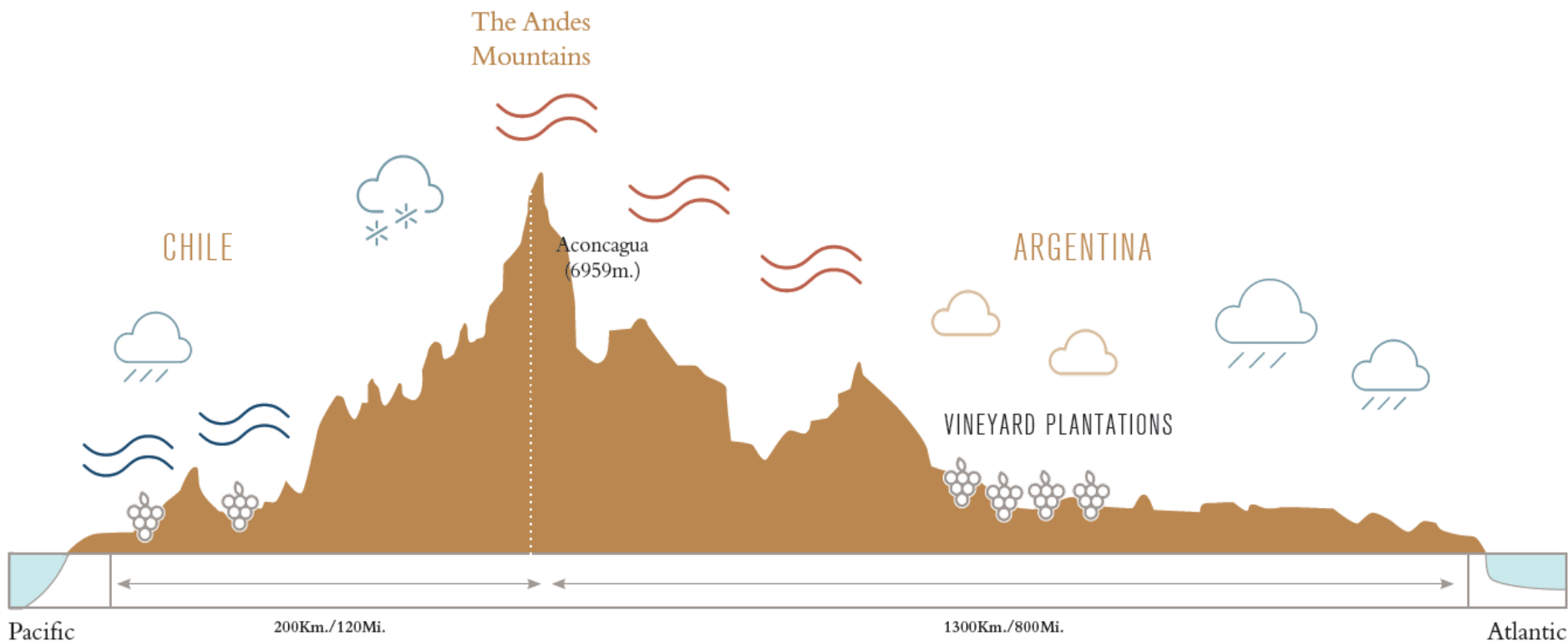

Higher diurnal temperature change



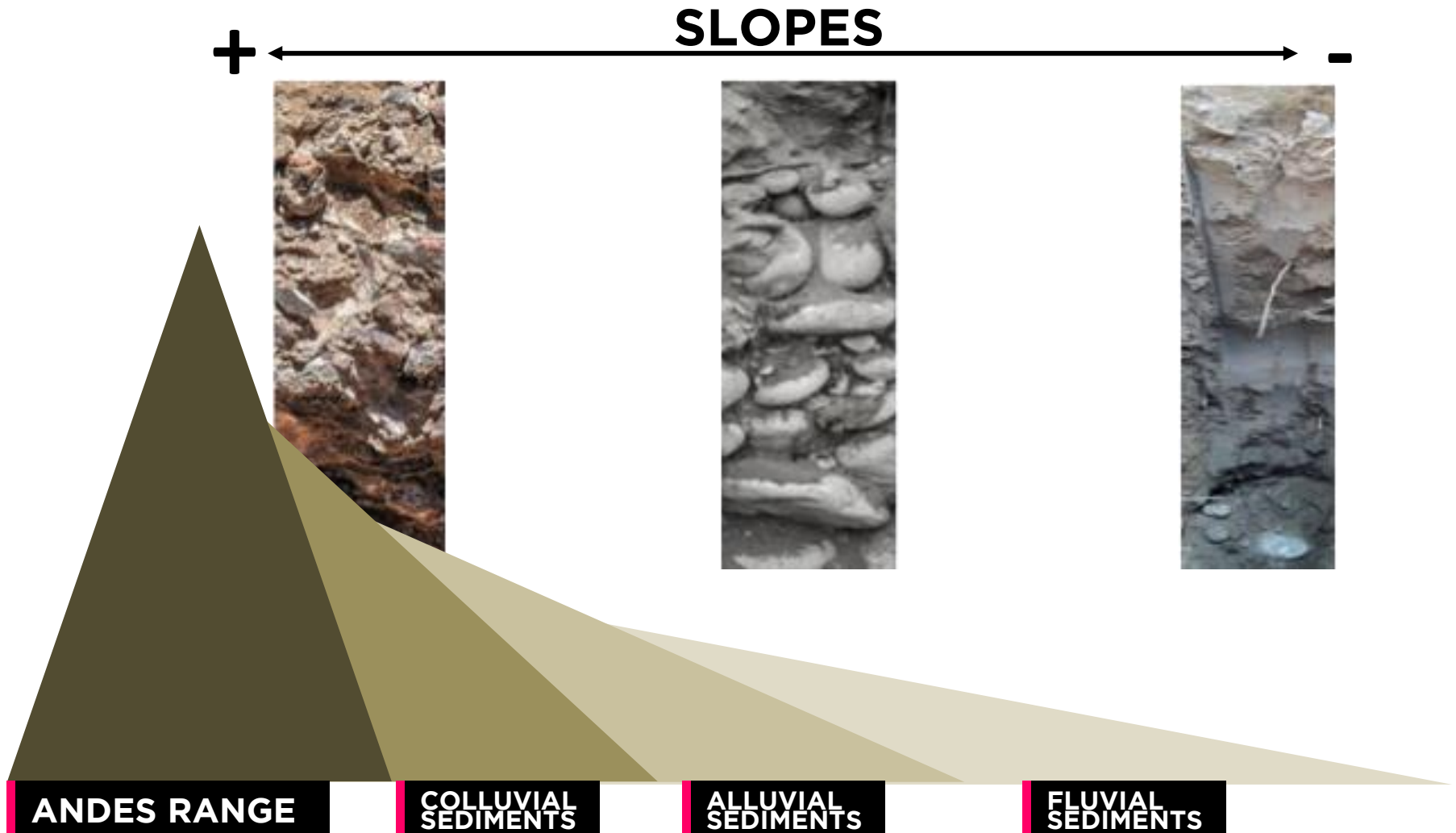

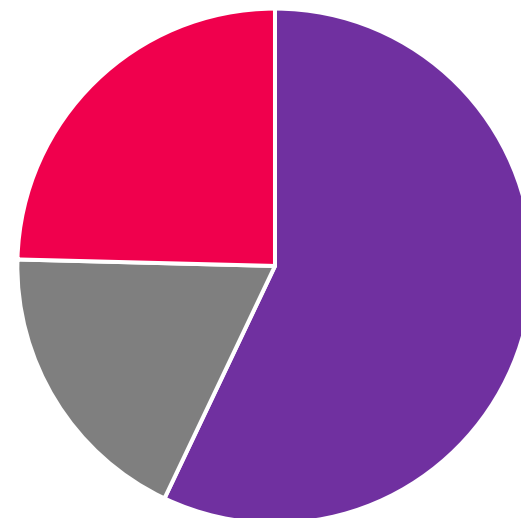


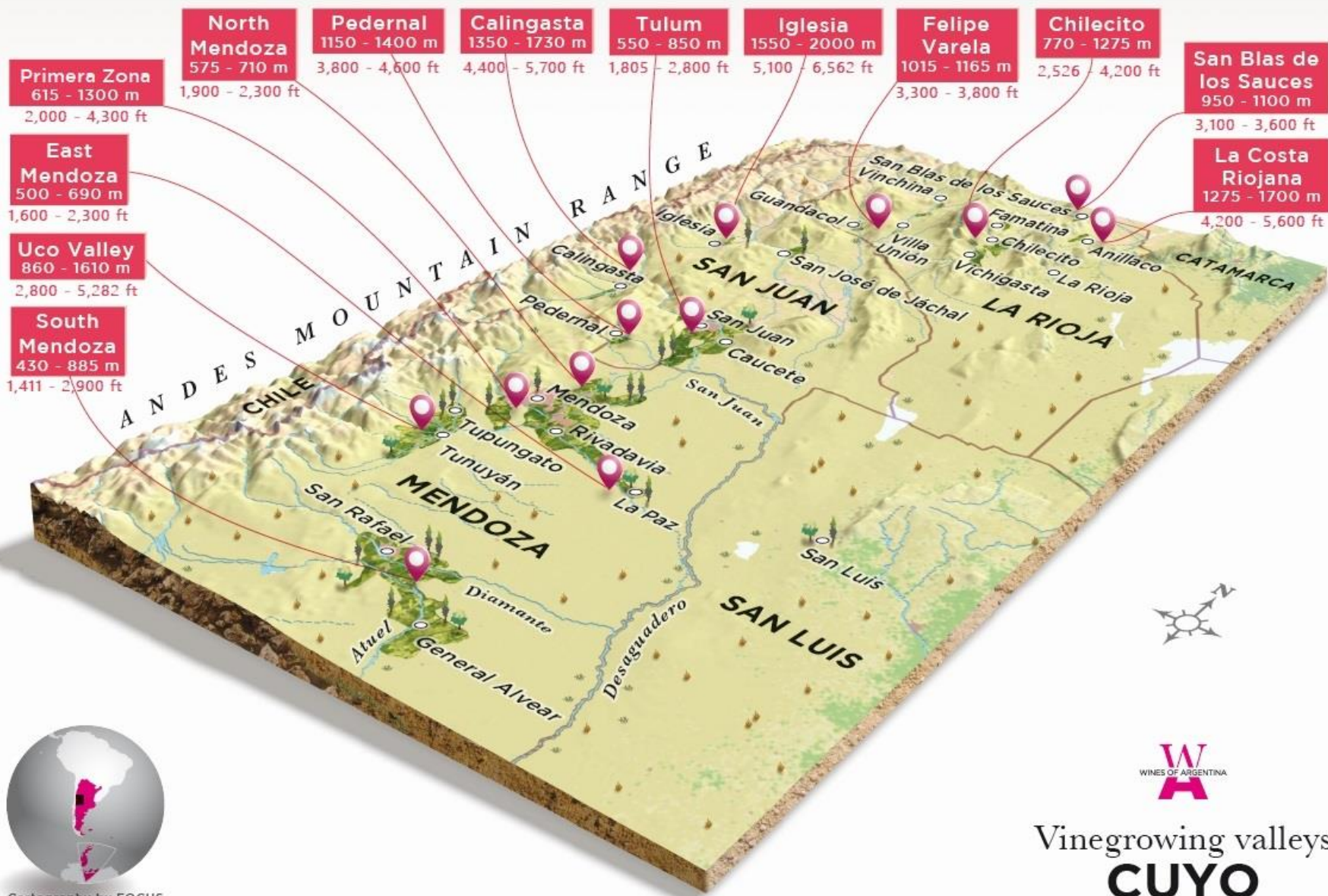
