In spite of being the 2nd smallest province, Tucumán is the most densely populated province in the country.

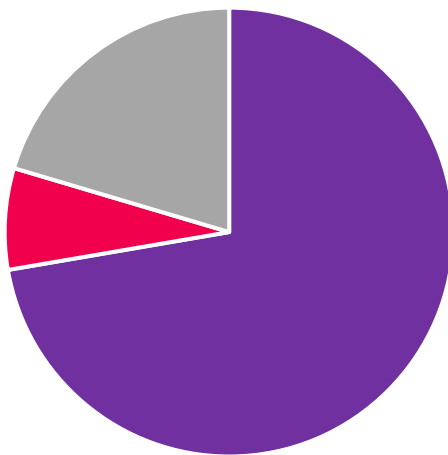

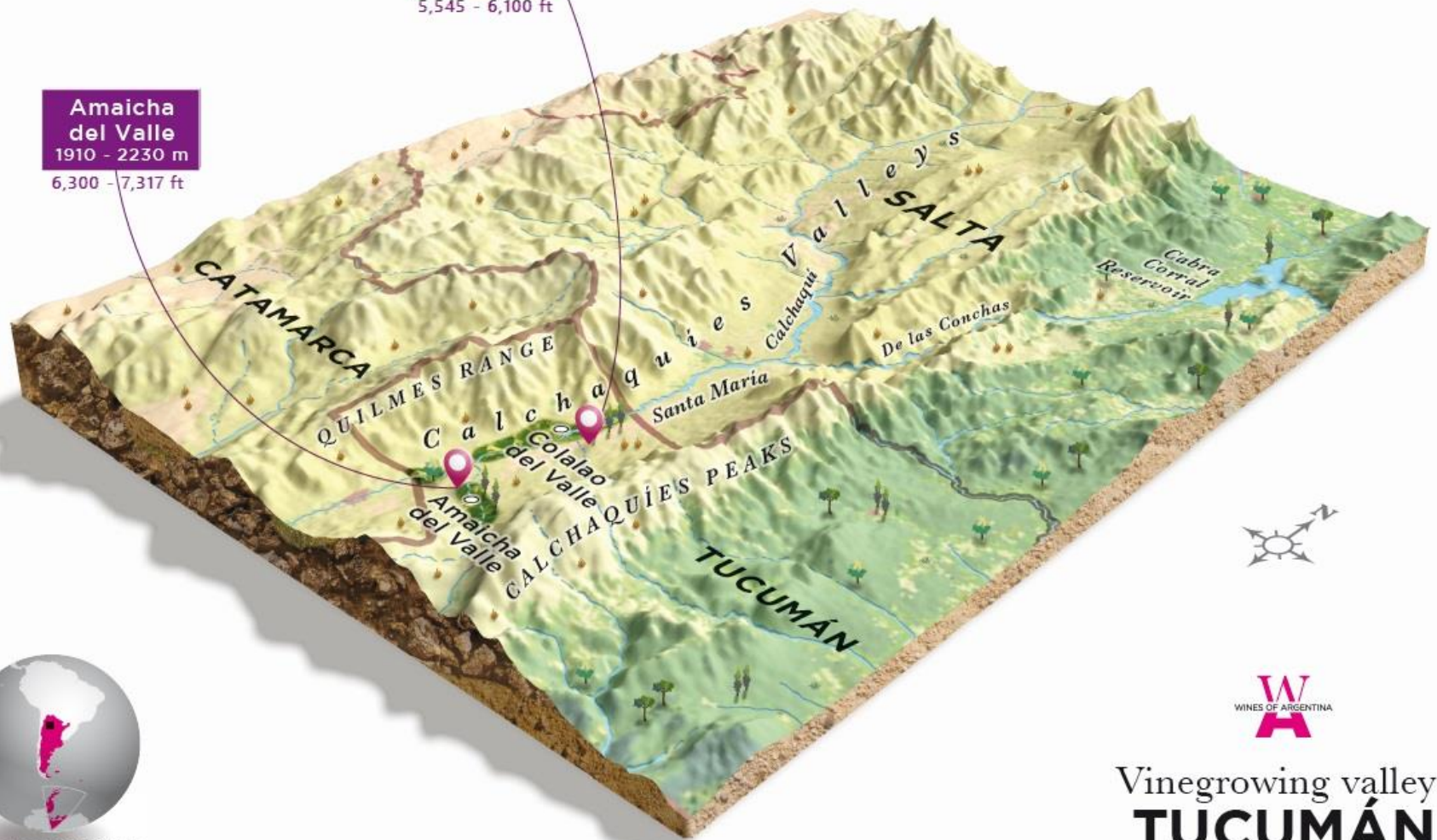
